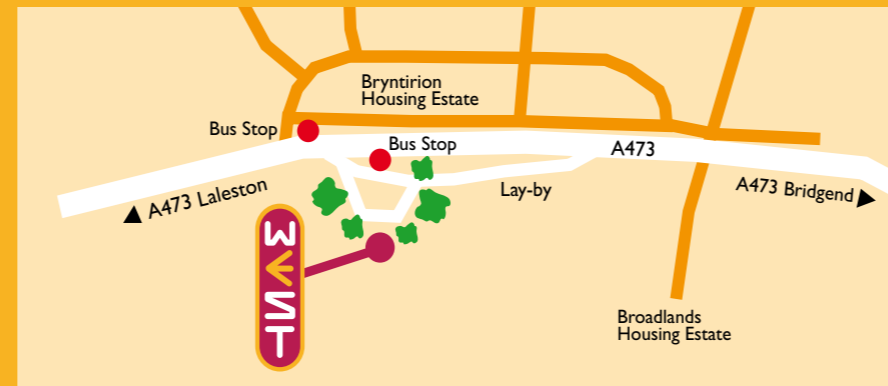

Speakers

Michael Haykin is Professor of Church History and Biblical Spirituality at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky. He has written extensively and is a sought after conference speaker. He was born in England of Irish and Kurdish parents. He is married to Alison and they have two children.

Hywel R Jones is Professor of Practical Theology at Westminster Seminary, California but now lives in Port Talbot. He was a pastor in UK for almost 20 years, principal of the London Theological Seminary and is author of several commentaries. He is married to Nansi and they have 3 adult children and 5 granddaughters.

Andrew Davies has also returned to South Wales – he lives in Cwmbran - after many years as a pastor in Wales (Free School Court), Australia, New Zealand and England and teaching at the London School of Theology and WEST. He is married to Pam and has 4 adult children and 10 grandchildren.

Gwyn Davies is WEST's Church History lecturer and an Elder of the Welsh Evangelical Church, Aberystwyth. He has written widely in both Welsh and English. He is originally from the South Wales valleys. He is married to Glenys and they have three adult children and two grandchildren.

Jonathan Stephen is the Principal of WEST and is an Elder at Broadlands Evangelical Church, Bridgend. He was previously a minister in both Reading and Twickenham (London). He is married to Sheila and they have one adult son.
