

# TUITION FEES 2013-14 – UK & EU Students

For the purpose of charging fees, a student is classed as a UK or EU student if he/she has been normally resident in the UK/EU for three years prior to commencing his/her course, and that residency has *not* been wholly or mainly for the purpose of full time education. Otherwise he/she will be classed as an overseas student.

Each year, fees for students who return to continue their studies on the same programme as the previous year will not increase by more than the rate of inflation plus 3%, for the duration of the programme. The rate of inflation will be the published rate at the time the fees are reviewed and set for the following academic year.

1. The complete MTh/MA (including year 2 of the Binary Course) comprises 180 credits: 6 x 20 credit Taught Modules followed by a Dissertation which is the equivalent of a further 60 credits.
2. The programme requires a total of 6 weeks of residential study to complete the Taught Modules. Accommodation is available on campus for a charge of £15 per night for a minimum of 3 consecutive nights. The charge for fewer than 3 nights is £18 per night. The meal charge of £8 per day covers breakfast, lunch and evening meal. All accommodation is subject to availability.
3. Each part time Taught Module has a value of 20 credits, with the exception of Church Placement (40 credits) and Research Methods (10 credits). On completion of 120 credits of Taught Modules, students enrol for the Dissertation, which has a value of a further 60 credits.
4. Non Accredited study offers the same modules as MTh or MA but without university accreditation or a degree award. Students may study as few or as many of the Taught Modules as they wish. Students of Non Accredited modules can choose whether to have their work assessed or not. The difference in charges reflects this.
