

# TUITION FEES 2013-14 – UK & EU Students

For the purpose of charging fees, a student is classed as a UK or EU student if he/she has been normally resident in the UK/EU for three years prior to commencing his/her course, and that residency has *not* been wholly or mainly for the purpose of full time education. Otherwise he/she will be classed as an overseas student.

3. Meals: Students paying the annual meal charge of £1050 will receive a lunch time and evening meal each day from Monday to Friday during term time (excludes vacation periods). Students not paying the annual charge must pre-book and pre-pay for all individual meals.
4. The non-accredited course covers the same modules as the BA/BD but without university accreditation; study does not lead to a degree award. Modules can be studied on campus or by distance learning mode.
5. Accommodation may be available on request on a *per night* basis for part time students.

For the purpose of charging fees, a student is classed as a UK or EU student if he/she has been normally resident in the UK/EU for three years prior to commencing his/her course, and that residency has *not* been wholly or mainly for the purpose of full time education. Otherwise he/she will be classed as an overseas student. By the middle of May 2013 we hope to be able to confirm our eligibility to accept students who need a Tier 4 Visa to study in the UK.
