

## FEES FOR UK & EU UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS 2014-15

### UNIVERSITY FEES

**compulsory for all students**

Full time students – per year	£500
Part time students – for each 10 credits studied	£42
Non-accredited students	£0

### FACILITIES FEE

**compulsory for all 2014-15 students**

Residential, full time students - per year	£300
Residential, part time students - for each 10 credits studied	£30
Non-residential, full time students – per year	£200
Non-residential, part time students – for each 10 credits studied	£20
Distance learning students	£0

#### NOTES

- For the purpose of charging fees, a student is classed as a UK or EU student if he/she has been normally resident in the UK/EU for three years prior to commencing his/her course, and that residency has not been wholly or mainly for the purpose of full time education.
- All fees apply to new students in the 2014-15 academic year, and are subject to change in subsequent years. Students who are continuing from the previous year may be charged different fees.
- A standard part time module has a value of 10 credits. However, some modules have a higher credit value and will be charged accordingly.
- Students wishing to live on campus can see the schedule of charges by downloading Accommodation Fees.
- Prices for lunch time and evening meals can be found by downloading Accommodation Fees
- The Facilities Fee is payable by all new undergraduates from 2014-15, apart from distance learning students, and covers the use of the School's general facilities, library, study areas and WiFi Broadband.
